The modules cover the topics of *Social Commerce*, *Influencer Marketing*, *Online Stores in Offline Spaces*, *AR-Powered Shopping Experiences*, *Ethical and Values-Based Brands*, *Same-day (or Faster) Delivery*, *Increased Use of Chatbots*, *Data Science-Based Personal Interaction*, *Pop up Stores*, *Customer experience onsite*.



What is next?



Right now, the partners are organising the pilot testing activities of the e-learning courses.

Each partner is responsible for the selection of its country's 15 pilot participants, who will be employees of retail SMEs. The main selection criterion will be the opportunity that each employee had in order to receive professional training on his/her subject, and those who hold the least will be prioritised.

After each group is selected, they will attend a series of e-learning courses where they will be taught the entire material in a classroom context.

Once the course is over, they will fill a targeted questionnaire where they will provide their feedback on aspects of the material such as clarity, easy of navigation, potentials of implementation in real life, plurality, appearance and overall contribution into their level of knowledge.
